

THE THREE CLASSIC WINE ON TAP INSTALLATIONS SYSTEMS

DIRECT DRAW (PLUG & PLAY):

- A kegerator is chosen according to your needs and requirements and is installed into an already existing space.
- This usually requires minimal effort.
- As well as minimum cost.
- P.S.: We can customize your kegerator by having both wines and beers tapped from the same box. Photo below: building three towers out of the same kegerator: Left is sparkling wine, middle is beer, right is white wine. Maximizing your space maximizes your revenues!



DIRECT DRAW (RETROFIT):

- Towers and taps are installed on a bar countertop.
- Sparkling & white wines are in a fridge underneath the bar.
- Red wines can be outside at room temperature.



LONG DRAW (BACK OF THE HOUSE):

- Kegs are stored in the back of the house (Sparkling and whites in a fridge/cooler, walk-in cold box, etc...), (reds outside at back room temperature unless too warm).
- Sparkling and white wines lines need to be kept cold through a glycol system trunk line.
