



BEL AIR VINESCENCE – BEAUJOLAIS WINES IN KEGS

Coop with impeccable reputation producing some of the best and most typical wines of Beaujolais appellations.

Beaujolais Blanc: This white wine are produced in Beaujolais from the Chardonnay grape variety. They make up only about two percent of the region's production. Very rare!!

A Beaujolais Blanc is typically light and fresh, with characteristic aromas of stone fruit, pears and melon. Somewhat similar to Macon Villages wines.

Beaujolais Villages Rouge: This red wine is 100% gamay grape and comes from the better classified villages vineyards. Intense deep red in color, with nose of carnations, red flowers, peonies, with notes of minerals, lead pencil, graphite quality. The wine is medium to full body on the palate with the same flavors with a rich, supple and round texture, velvety with soft tannins, and a long flavor packed finish.

TAPWINES 100% SYRAH ROSE – IGP PAYS D’OC

This wine is a small unique CUVÉE from a family estate located near the Costières de Nîmes area known to produce awesome Syrah based wines, because of its micro climate.

This 100% Syrah Rose wine is pale pink in color (Provence style), due to a short maceration (6 to 8 hours) on the skins. It is then pressed and temperature controlled stainless steel vats fermented. 50% of the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation, which gives it more body without taking away its crisp tone. Nose of nectarine, white peach, pomelo, medium body on the palate, with the same ripe and supple fruit flavors enhanced by a touch of minerality, finishing round and juicy.
